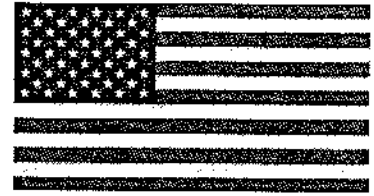

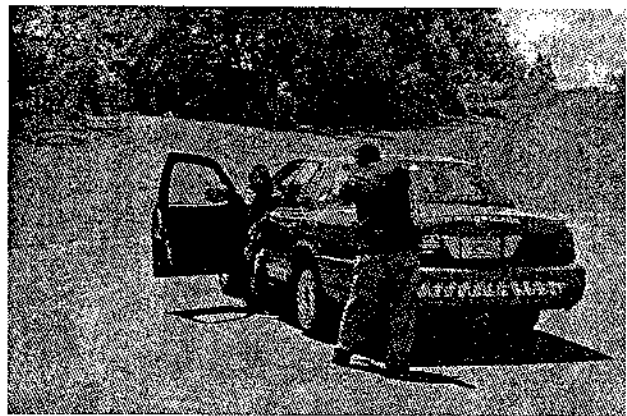


2017 International Police Association World Seminar for Young Police Officers

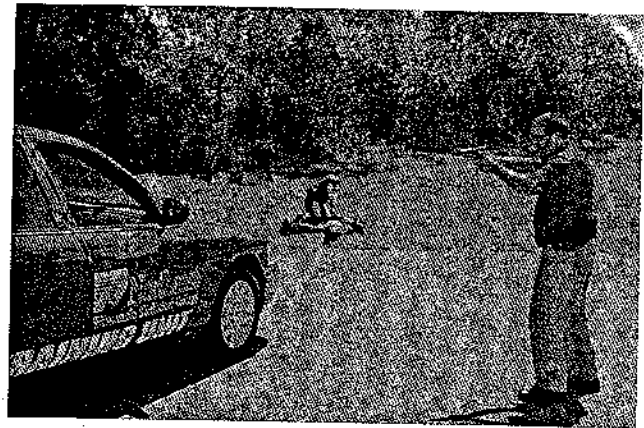


We are working with several options for housing possibilities including apartment style college dormitories at St. Norbert's College, and the possibility of
