Organization for Human Rights Defence- OADO - is non-governmental organization of national and public interest, specialized in complex issues of what knowledge, promotion and protection of fundamental human rights means as they are stipulated in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights on December 10, 1948. OADO was established immediately after the Revolution of 1989, in April 1990, and aims to promote the principles of the UN Charter and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in restoring democracy and economic and social reforms in post-totalitarian Romania.

According to the Law nr. 554/2004 regarding Legal Administrative the organization is assimilated with the public authorities and works as public powers, is acting vividly both in internal but also in international civic society, keeps in touch with European institutions and with the main UN-bodies, which are implied in promotion of the rights and freedoms of the human beings, is a juridical institution of national interest and public utility, member with special consultative status of UNO-ECOSOC, with permanent representatives in New York, Geneva and Vienna, participant member of the European Council, with permanent representatives in Strasbourg and Brussels, and collective member of the Academy of Scientists from Romania.
